*Delegates must complete the Safety Awareness module prior to completing the Drain and Sewer module. The Safety Awareness certification is valid for 3 years, but the Drain and Sewer module does not need to be refreshed if trainees have a valid Safety Awareness certificate.

Flowplant Courses

Jetter Safety Awareness (One Day). This course ensures trainees are fully aware and appreciate the importance of safe working practices with high pressure water jetting.
