

WJA Safety Awareness Course

The WJA Safety Awareness course is the essential starting point for anyone involved in high-pressure water jetting. This one-day, classroom-based course forms the foundation for all further WJA training and must be completed before any practical module can be undertaken.

- **New operatives** entering the water jetting industry
- **Existing staff** needing WJA certification renewal
- **Supervisors, team leaders, and safety personnel** overseeing jetting teams

No previous experience is required. It's suitable for all industries including drainage, utilities, oil & gas, construction, and cleaning.

- Typical **applications, risks**, and operator **responsibilities**

The course is delivered through a mix of presentations, group discussion, Q&A sessions, and guided reflection on real-life jetting injuries and near-misses.
